I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1.The "Best Student of the Year" competition is held among students of academic groups in various fields of study with the purpose of motivating and encouraging students to acquire deep and solid knowledge, as well as to pursue continuous personal and professional self-development.


1.2.These Regulations define the goals and objectives, participant categories, procedure for conducting the competition, and the process for summarizing the results during the academic year.

II. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE COMPETITION

2.1.The main goal of the competition is to satisfy students' need for self-realization, develop their business activity, general and cultural competencies, and support student initiatives.

2.2.Objectives of the competition:

- to increase students' motivation for academic, scientific, practical, sports, and social activities;
- to involve young people in creative activities;
- to increase students' motivation to participate in socially significant activities;
- to develop students' leadership competencies;
- to create conditions for the implementation of student initiatives;
- to increase students' interest in their chosen profession and specialty;
- to enhance the personal potential of competition participants;
- to create an atmosphere of creativity, cooperation, and healthy competition within the student community;
- to stimulate and encourage systematic self-education activities of students, taking into account their individual abilities and interests.

III. PARTICIPANTS OF THE COMPETITION

3.1.The competition is open to students:

- of all years of study;
- who demonstrate high achievements in academic, sports, cultural, scientific-research, social activities, and student self-government activities.

3.2.Candidates for participation in the competition shall be nominated by the academic group.

3.3.The selection of candidates shall take place at a general group meeting through secret voting or by self-nomination.

IV. ORGANIZING COMMITTEE AND EXPERT COMMISSION OF THE COMPETITION

4.1.The main governing body of the competition shall be the Organizing Committee.

4.2.The Organizing Committee shall provide organizational, legal, informational, and methodological support for the competition, organize its implementation, prepare the necessary competition tasks and documentation, determine evaluation criteria for each stage of the competition, supervise the competition process, establish procedures, and register the results of the competition tasks.


4.3.The Organizing Committee shall include members of the Student Senate, a representative of the Educational and Methodological Department, Heads of Departments, and the Dean.

4.4.The Expert Commission shall be formed by the Organizing Committee.

V. PROCEDURE FOR CONDUCTING THE COMPETITION

5.1.The competition shall be held annually with the corresponding results summarized upon completion.

5.2.The competition shall consist of three stages:

Stage I – conducted separately in each academic group, where contestants are selected from among the nominated candidates;

Stage II – a self-presentation competition is conducted for each candidate, where the winners of the first stage compete against each other; the results are determined by the commission;

Stage III (Final Stage) – winners of the second stage participate, and the final results are determined by the commission.

5.3. The winner of the first stage shall be awarded the title:
"Best Student of the Group."

5.4. The winner of the second stage shall be awarded the title:
"Best Student of the Specialty."

5.5. The winner of the third stage shall be awarded the title:
"Best Student of the Year."

VI. SUMMARIZING RESULTS AND AWARDING WINNERS

6.1. The competition results shall be summarized by the commission based on the total points earned by participants at each stage of the competition.

6.2. Based on the competition results, the winner of the "Best Student of the Year" competition shall be determined and awarded a diploma and a trophy.

6.3. Winners of other nominations shall be awarded diplomas and commemorative prizes.

6.4. All other participants shall receive certificates of participation.

6.5. The results of the competition shall be published on the official website of the University.
